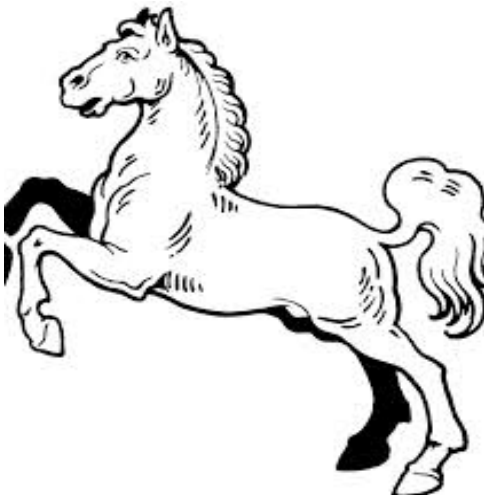
Dancing with Angie will be on again this Thursday.

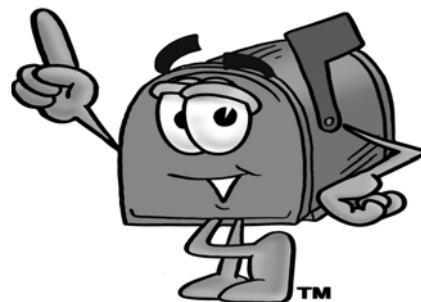

2013 School Fees

Metal Technology	\$60.00 - plus individual purchase of materials
Textiles Technology	\$20.00 - plus individual purchase of materials
Agriculture	\$10.00 - plus individual purchase of materials
Stage 6 Hospitality	\$30.00 per term - plus \$50 uniform hire or purchase of own uniform
