Principal's Message

My congratulations and thanks to everyone, students and staff and parents, for their hard work to ensure Term 3 has started so smoothly. We are off to a flying start! Term 2 was extremely busy and I can see that Term 3 will be equally so, with many activities to look forward to.

Best wishes to students - Demmi Bennett, Naomi Fishpool, Sammy Dunn, Leonie Jones, Danielle Harding and Jack Bennett, who will be competing at the CHS WA Athletics Carnival in Bathurst on Friday this week.

My congratulations go also to Bridget Bennett. On Thursday last week, Bridget played extremely well in the Western Area Tennis 'ranking process'. Bridget won all her matches and is now the 'number 1 seed' in the WA Girls' Tennis Team.

At the end of last term Secondary students participated in a two week trial involving the use of mobile phones at school. I am pleased to say that the vast majority of students followed the mobile phone policy and rules that had been set. This means that this term Secondary students will be allowed to bring their mobile phones to school, provided that they have a signed agreement. These students are only allowed to use their mobile phone in an appropriate manner at recess and lunchtime, and only in the secondary quadrangle.

Students who ride their bikes to school must wear a helmet and follow normal road safety rules for cyclists. I have asked the students who ride bikes to enter and exit the school either by the gates near the library or by the gate near the Industrial Arts workshop, depending on where they live. For safety reasons, we are trying to avoid bikes on the road near the bus bays and at the intersection of Merilba and Meryula Streets.

Could I also remind all parents to ensure that their children are not arriving at school before 8.35am.

It is important that if your child is away from school that a note should be sent to school, the

following day and given to the class teacher, explaining the absence.

Finally, as we move through winter, I would ask all parents to ensure that their children wear the correct winter uniform every day. This includes the correct footwear- preferably fully enclosed, black leather shoes.

Tomorrow night there is a P&C meeting commencing at 7.00pm - all parents welcome. Next week is Education Week and we are having "Open Classrooms" on Wednesday the 31st of July, starting at 11.20am and followed by a BBQ lunch at 1.00pm. There will be a "Book Fair" in the Library between 11.20am and 2.00pm. A large range of books and other items will be on sale. In the afternoon the SRC are running 'Jump Rope for Heart' activities on the town tennis courts. I urge everyone to come along and enjoy another top day at Tottenham CS!

MERIT SYSTEM

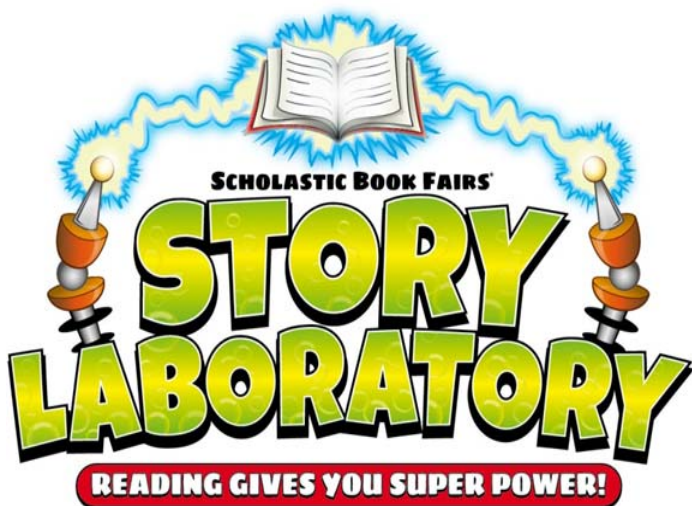

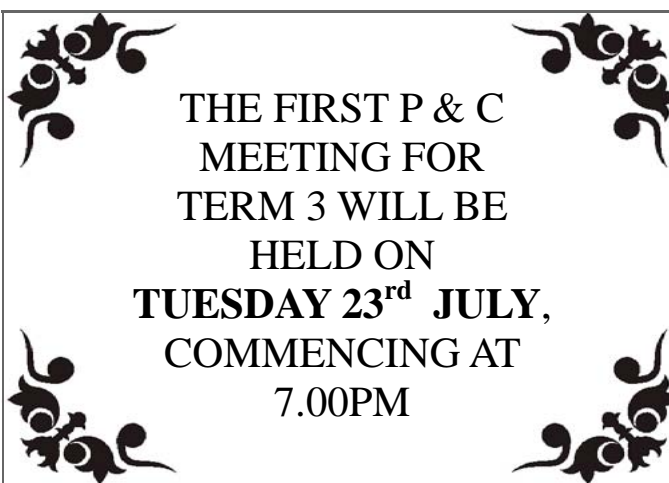
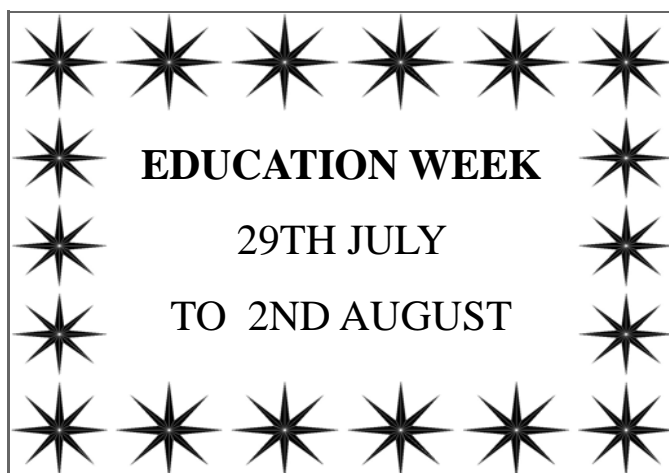
YEARS 4/5/6 FUNDRAISER– PIE DRIVE

OPEN DAY & BOOK FAIR IN EDUCATION WEEK

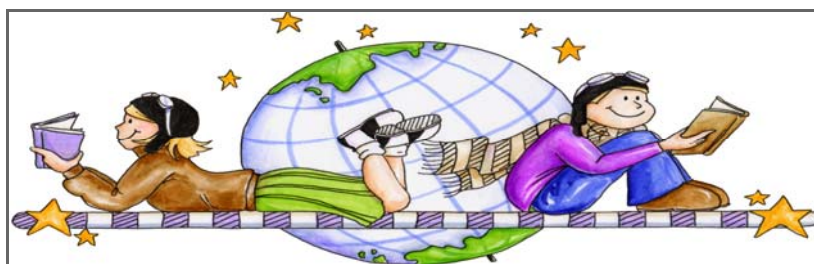

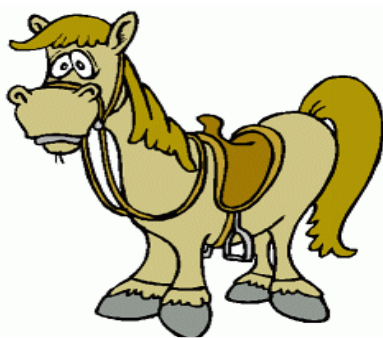

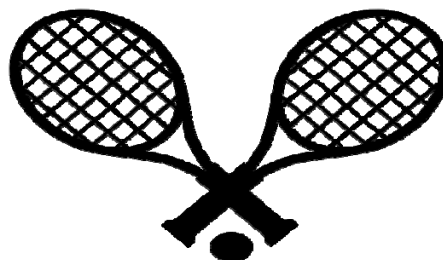
