Principal's message

Professional Learning Over the Last Week

Mrs Finlay and I attended professional learning for the newly released Enterprise Financial Planning Tool (eFPT). This budgeting tool ensures efficient and effective allocation of human resources, funding and school physical resources.

Mrs Smith and Miss Elwin have spent two days at a professional workshop learning about the effective implementation of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) in schools. Mrs Smith and Miss Elwin will present their findings to all staff and planning will commence for the launch of our whole school STEM program in 2018.

Primary Captains 2018

There will be changes to our student leadership structure in 2018. Next year and beyond, there will be no vice-captains elected. We will have a secondary captain, a primary boy captain and a primary girl captain. Our elected SRC members will be given increased roles in the school, including taking turns to lead assemblies with our school captains.
