## Principal's message

### Perpetual Trophies

Perpetual Trophies awarded at Presentation Ceremony last year need to be returned to the office to allow for this year's Presentation Ceremony to be organised.

### Updates to Mask Wearing Requirements

Under Level 3 settings, masks are **required** indoors for all staff and students in Year 7 and above. Masks are **strongly recommended** indoors for primary students.

Mask wearing advice has been updated to require all students aged 12 and above, as well as all staff, to wear a mask or face covering when travelling to and from school and during school excursions by public transport or by chartered or private transport services.

All visitors to school sites are required to wear a mask at all times.

### COVID Intensive Learning Support Program (COVID ILSP)

The NSW Government has committed additional funding to continue the COVID Intensive Learning Support Program (COVID ILSP) until the end of 2022. The program was launched this year to improve educational outcomes for students whose learning has been most impacted by the pandemic.

### New Sign In Procedure

As of Monday, we have a new QR code that must be used. Our previous QR code is now obsolete. The new QR code will take you to Services NSW "School Check In" where you will need to fill in some very basic information. This procedure will also ensure all contractors and volunteers are double vaccinated before commencing work.

Congratulations to all the combined winning teams of the Kerri Parkes Western Challenge Debating Competition 2021.

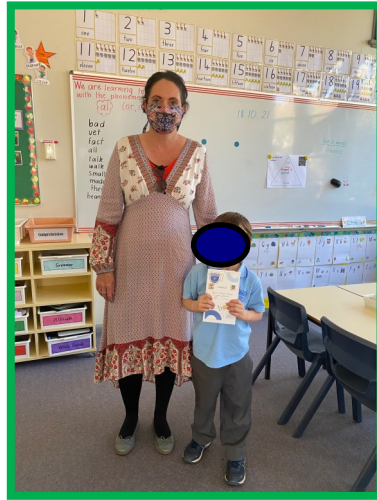
